Baptist Convention of New York: Churches Partnering Together to Lead All Peoples to Become Christ Followers

With people working together more can be accomplished than one working alone. That is the theme of Southern Baptists - on the mission field, in our churches, in our giving, and even in times of devastation. Disaster Relief teams from across our territory and throughout the nation have been very active here in the Northeast following the Hurricanes/Tropical Storms of Irene and Lee. In the BCNY territory, the Disaster Relief needs were so wide-spread, help was needed within the territory served by six of our nine associations. In addition to teams from a variety of states, the largest number of local volunteers in BCNY history responded to the plea for help at Trinity Baptist Church in Niskayuna. Over 150 volunteers assisted in preparing sandwiches that were transported to several locations.

In addition, 310 students from Liberty University worked in the Southern Tier in two 5-day teams. This marked the first time in history that such a large number of students were mobilized to assist Disaster Relief during a school term. Their training was provided by the North American Mission Board and the Virginia Baptist Convention. I am grateful for the assistance and ministry of the many who served. I am also grateful for the Syracuse University students who participated in one of those weekends and Davis College students who helped intermittently in the entire effort. November 6 will mark the last day of the 40 Day

Season of Prayer that began after the BCNY Annual Meeting. As early as November 7, the President of the Baptist Convention of New York will appoint a seven member Task Force. This team will be a part of multiple listening sessions that are being planned for individuals from each region and ethnic group. The sessions will be designed for expressions of concerns and insights into the future work of the BCNY. The Task Force will also meet with the BCNY Executive Board both in the Spring and Fall in preparation to present a strategy and vision plan at the Baptist Convention Annual Meeting in 2012. Please keep these matters in prayer.

PRAYING: The Week of Prayer for International

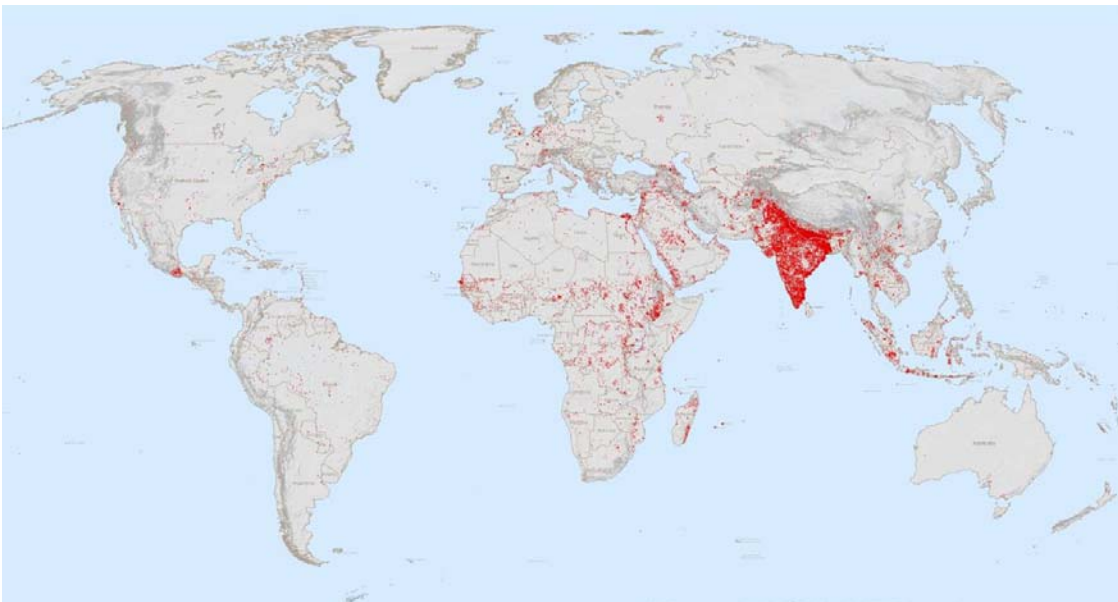
Missions is December 4-11, 2011. Lead your church to pray according to the prayer guides you will receive in November from the BCNY office. If you do not receive them by the middle of the month, then you will need to order them through the BCNY web-site.

Available on-line at www.imb.org, is a free downloadable journal entitled, Getting There. It a resource for individual use, small group, or church-wide use that encourages choosing an unreached people group, researching basic details about them, and a seven day prayer plan for them.

GIVING: Involve your church in giving to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. This year's national goal is 175 million dollars. Remember we can do more together than we can alone. Eternities are at stake.

GOING: Encourage your church to go. Go where people don't speak your language, go to places that might make you uncomfortable, go into the world! Encourage your people to get their passport, take time off from work, dig into their pockets and GO.

Featuring a personal story from across the BCNY territory

Victor Cordero came to Syracuse, NY when his father passed away. He came with the intention of remodeling the home his father had left to him and selling it. It was a short term plan. Setting roots in Syracuse was not part of the plan, but God had another plan in place for Victor and his family.

Across the neighborhood a Latin Restaurant was closing its doors. After many years of giving the community some Latin flavor through some great food, Pedro and Ada Abreu felt the call of God to give that same community a different kind of food; the kind that would transform their lives forever. So, they founded Iglesia Bautista Transformación or Transformation Baptist Church in November 2009 after remodeling the restaurant to turn it into a church. Pastor Pedro, now retired from the Army as well, had been working as social worker for the Syracuse School District in the same neighborhood after getting his Master’s Degree from Syracuse University.

As we engaged in worship during a recent Sunday morning service a tall, robust, serious, and sharply dressed gentleman came in and stood in the back with a very suspicious demeanor. As I looked to the back of the church a couple of minutes later the man was gone. The following Sunday he was back. Again he stood in the back. But this time he stayed through the worship before he left. For a third straight Sunday he returned. He grabbed a chair and sat in the back as he listened to the worship and Pastor Pedro Abreu presented the Gospel. This time he filled out a visitor’s card and we found out his name and contact information.

Mr Victor Cordero, known also as Sergeant Major Cordero, continued to visit the church and asked us to come visit him. This Iraq veteran also opened his doors for a men’s bible study in the west side of Syracuse where the church is located. Pretty soon we had a room full of men who didn’t know Christ in Victor’s living room listening to the message of Jesus Christ. But we were praying for Victor to surrender his life to Christ. We knew he was a person of peace and that he had a lot of influence in the community.

On Sunday, July 24 2011, a summer missionary preached at Iglesia Bautista Transformación. That morning Victor surrendered his life to God. And while tears were unexpected from a tall, robust and serious looking retired US Army Captain, it reflected the transforming power of the Holy Spirit working in Victor’s life. Today he is full of joy as he trains for a greater cause. Today he proclaims that he is part of God’s army.

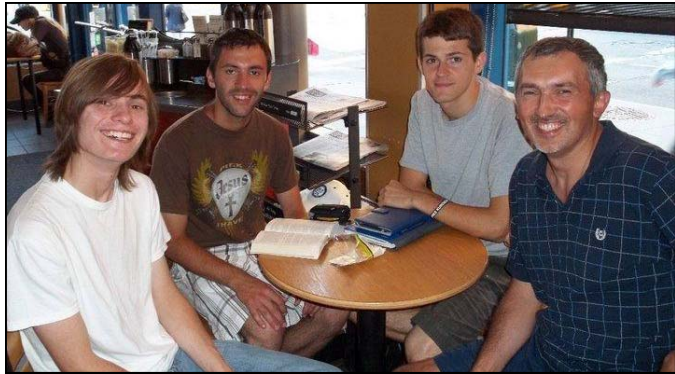

## *A Busy Season for Disaster Relief* by Michael Flannery BCNY Disaster Relief Director

On August 27, 2011, Hurricane Irene made its way to New York State and several days later on her heels was Tropical Storm Lee. The state was bracing only for Irene and we were surprised when Lee hit with tremendous amounts of rain for days. We had no idea just how much of an impact these two storms were to have on our State Convention. Only several days after the storms made their way through our areas did we begin to receive calls for assistance.

Our first request came from the Red Cross to set up the Baptist Convention of New York feeding unit in Washingtonville, NY. This was in an area where we did not have any Southern Baptist churches, so Grace Community Church allowed our unit to set up in their facility to be a staging area for feeding with the Red Cross. We worked with the Red Cross, Emergency Management offices in Washingtonville, NY to begin preparing meals for displaced residents of the surrounding communities. The first teams to arrive to begin preparing meals were from Pearl River Baptist Association in Mississippi and our own trained volunteers from State Convention. While in Washingtonville, we also deployed the shower unit from Hudson Baptist Association. We served in Washingtonville, from August 28, 2011 to Sept. 19, 2011 when our unit was moved to Johnson City, New York. During the time that we were in the Washingtonville area we also sent meals to Prattsville, NY where the whole town was flooded and needed immediate assistance, so along with meals we sent in a team from NAMB to train the community in mud out procedures.

While serving in Washingtonville, there was another call out need from the Red Cross for assistance in feeding in Niskayuna, NY which is just east of Schenectady, NY. With our unit already in Washingtonville, NY, we were able to enlist the Kentucky Baptist Convention feeding unit to come and set up their units at Trinity Baptist Church. There were several days during this time, Sept. 9-Sept.19, 2011 that we called on untrained volunteers and trained volunteers to help in preparing 10,000 meals a day. There were over 200 volunteers on several days preparing meals and lunches for the Red Cross while being directed by the Kentucky Feeding unit. Upon closing the feeding unit in Niskayuna, NY on Sept. 19, 2011 we moved our feeding unit to Binghamton, New York at Davis College in Johnson City. During all this time there was a unit from Virginia in the New Jersey Net association working on

mud outs in northern New Jersey. They were working with Elaine and Dennis O'Neill to assist the residents affected by the flooding in their area.

Upon arriving at Davis College in Johnson City, New York the Incident Command team had set up operations and began working with teams to prepare meals for the surrounding counties. On a daily basis we were preparing at least 5000 meals for flood victims and their families. We were in the Binghamton area from Sept. 19- October 4, 2011 serving meals and doing mud-outs in Tioga and Owego counties.

I want to thank God for the 68 houses that we were able to assist over the past week. On Friday Sept. 23-27, 2011 and Sept.30-Oct, 4, 2011. We were blessed by 310 students from Liberty University in Lynchburg, VA and 25 students from Syracuse University that completed 68 houses in recovery mud. This was the first time that we partnered with a major university to this extent and with the help of NAMB, the Southern Baptist Convention of Virginia and our volunteers it was a major success and much was accomplished. As of Wednesday, Oct.5, 2011 the recovery operations at Davis College closed down because there were no mud out units scheduled to come in to assist homeowners. Please be in prayer for those who are still in need of assistance. During this difficult time two people accepted Christ as their Savior and as a direct result of this disaster call out, the Lord has opened the doors for a Laotian Thai church plant in the Johnson City area.

Finally I would like to express appreciation for all those who volunteered during this call out. We had volunteers from New England, Tennessee, Missouri, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Illinois, Texas, New Mexico, Idaho/Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania/So. Jersey, South Carolina, Ohio, Georgia, Kentucky, Florida and all the volunteers (trained and untrained) from the Baptist Convention of New York. I want to thank our own team leaders, Mark Banks, Billy Mitchell, Elaine and Dennis O'Neill, Lamar Duke, Terry Robertson and the North American Mission Board Disaster Relief Incident Command teams, Ed and Loretta Greene and Leon and Nell Branch. Also I want to thank those that have given to the Baptist Convention of New York to new mud units for our state. This will be useful in the future of our Disaster Relief in the Baptist Convention of New York.

## Reports From the Recipients of the 2011 James Mission Offering

**First Baptist Silver Creek—Family Emphasis Week/VBS**—As part of the Family Emphasis Week/VBS First Baptist Church hosted the town's Recreation Program for the first week in the summer. Attendance averaged 38, with 34 of those finishing the week once they started. Sports activities took place in the morning, a break for lunch, and during the afternoon practice for a musical called *Livin' Inside Out* was held. At the end of the week the presentation of the musical was performed for the town, with dinner following. The church continues to seek ways to minister to the families that attended that week, sharing the Gospel, as well as the Love of Christ.

**The Journey, NYC Servant Evangelism**—One of the important ways that The Journey Church in New York City is able to reach the people of the city is through Servant Evangelism. Servant Evangelism is a way to show God's love in a practical way to the people of the city while also inviting them to church. Members of The Journey meet in strategic locations throughout the city and hand out free granola bars, bottles of water or packs of gum along with invite cards to the church to people who walk by.

The Journey holds at least one Servant Evangelism project every month. And during the summer missions teams come to participate in Servant Evangelism projects throughout the city.

But in March, July and October all of The Journey's Growth Groups participate in a week long Servant Evangelism emphasis. During each of those weeks their goal was to make between 20,000 and 30,000 Servant Evangelism touches. The James Missions Offering enabled The Journey to purchase granola bars and print invite cards for the Growth Group weeks in 2011.

How has that made an impact? So far in 2011 The Journey has seen record first time decisions for Jesus and record baptisms (122 so far). Many of these individuals attended The Journey for the first time because of a Servant Evangelism touch.

**Medical Missions Philippines**— Bible Church International, Randolph NJ, took a team of doctors, nurses, dentists, pharmacists and church family members of all ages to serve in this medical mission endeavor. Through the seven sites visited in the Philippines, 2,538 people were treated and of that 1,862 people accepted Christ. (Individual site statistics are listed below.)

**Haiti Relief Fund**— New Hope Baptist Church in Watertown NY received some of the Haiti Relief Funds for assistance on their medical trip to Haiti. This team served 500 patients, performed 30 surgeries. In addition to the medical aspect of the trip, they also worked on water systems, electricity, in a destitute farming village, and an orphanage. Additional funding was given to the French Speaking Church in Brooklyn to assist them in their outreach to the Haitian people.

**Youth Evangelism Conference**—The "YEC" is the convention- wide event for middle school and high school students. With this year's theme "LIVE OUT LOUD", this event provided the students with the opportunity to hear evangelistic messages, go deep in the word during breakout sessions, and hear about mission opportunities, all while sharing the experience of their Christian walk with their peers. The YEC was held on May 20-22 at Iroquois Springs in Rock Hill, NY. The weekend resulted in 41 total decisions. 19 students professed Christ as their Savior for the first time and 16 others rededicated their lives. God also gave the opportunity to encourage 6 students who responded in response to God's calling to ministry. Please pray for each of these students who made decisions as they seek God's guidance for their life.

**Vacation Bible School Training**— 27 leaders attended LifeWay's Vacation Bible School Institute in January. Those well-trained individuals were joined by others and conducted 6 VBS training events in 2011— 4 in English and 2 in Spanish (North Country, Canton NY; Central New York Liverpool, NY; Metro West, Edison NJ; Metro North, Spring Valley NY; Spanish locations were in Passaic NJ and Brooklyn NY) Frontier Baptist Association continued their long-standing tradition of offering VBS Early Bird Clinic. Some 250 leaders were trained in these events.

**Women's Ministry Leadership**—Several BCNY Women's Tapestry and Association events were held in the spring and summer of 2011. In May 2011, the funds were used in helping with a Pastor's wives event in MNYBA. In June a cooperative partnership with Cathy Charles of the Finger Lakes Association held a overnight retreat/ workshop sessions. Over 30 women attended the highlighted WMU ministry/training. Also in June Beverly Flannery from the Frontier Association held "Ladies Day" geared toward Women's Evangelism at "The Well". Training events such as sharing your testimony were one of the highlighted workshops.

**BCNY Disaster Relief**— The funds for BCNY Disaster Relief were placed in the budget for the needs that would arrive. As was reported on page 6 of this issue of *The New York Baptist*, those funds were used to assist in the needs that came due to the flooding caused by Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee.

Sunday Evening, September 25, 2011, Kevin Ezell addressed the convention, first with a sermon followed by a Question and Answer time.

Speaking from Acts chapter 20, he challenged the messengers and visitors with this statement. "God often calls us to do something greater than we are capable of doing."

Speaking of revival, he gave this illustration:



'How does revival start?' Go into a room with some chalk. Bend down, and with the chalk draw a big circle on the floor. Step inside of the circle and pray that God will begin revival in that circle.

"We must penetrate the darkness in North America-but it starts in that chalk circle."

During the question and answer, Ezell fielded the following questions ( reported in abbreviated form):

**From Wayne Sibrava**, messenger from Living Water Baptist Church in Owego, NY: (*concerning the newly appointed church planting strategists*) Will they have a quota of churches that they are required to begin?

**Ezell:** Goal? Yes. Quota? No There is an expectation of four new churches per year. That being said, each area is unique and will be evaluated accordingly.

**From Don Thoms**, messenger from Grace Baptist Church in Ogdensburg, NY: What is your definition of church planting and disciple according to the Great Commission?



**Ezell:** NAMB desires to assist churches in making disciples and in church planting. Only 4% of our churches are directly involved in church planting.

**From Rick Wilburn**, messenger from Tupper Lake Baptist Church: (*after expressing concern with that what hasn't been working in the past and with the North American Mission Board funding and changes*) Why should we trust you now?

**Ezell:** The staff in Alpharetta has been tweaked and changed. Only 160 employees have remained and they are diligently working to make every role that had not been working more effective.

**From Bruce Aubrey**, messenger from Northside Baptist Church in Liverpool, NY: (*after expressing appreciation for the work that Kevin has done under difficult circumstances*) How do we best play pray for you, personally and for NAMB?

**Ezell:** (personally) for my children...this has been difficult for them and the adjustments that they have had to make and continue to make

(for NAMB) for those who have taken on additional responsibilities and for those who have been transitioned out

**From Stan Gilcash**, messenger from New Hope Baptist Church in Watertown NY: The small and rural churches relied heavily on the Evangelism and Church Growth divisions, so who is there to help them now?

**Ezell:** LifeWay remains a valid resource, as does World Changers and NAMB. Other help includes:

"SBCShare" is a website available that has free resources available to all pastors.

"Renew" is a new work in progress that offers "at risk" churches to be partnered with a healthy church to obtain help and funding.

Other areas being developed associationally a crisis management system where churches help churches and a 'mentor match-making' program that matches pastor to pastor.

Every dollar saved has been put back on the field.

The 42nd Annual Meeting of the Baptist Convention of New York was held at New Hope Baptist Church in Watertown NY on September 25-26. The following is a brief report.

Terry Robertson addressed the convention on Monday afternoon. His text was 1 Corinthians 2:14-3:11. His challenge was for the convention was to continue to be co-laborers, some will plant, some will water. His plea was to be in a state of active duty. Reach the lost and pray ( "pray for yourself, pray for your families, pray for your church, pray for your association and other churches). He introduced the Vision Task Force plan during the business session, and it later was tweaked with a motion, and the approval came at the third Business Session.

### Annual Sermon:

Robbie Lankford , pastor at New Hope Community Church in Queensbury NY delivered the annual sermon. His text was Psalm 2:8, and was entitled "It Can Happen Here!" He told the convention that New York was once referred to as the "Burned-Over District." During the time of the Second Great Awakening, regions of New York had been so heavily evangelized there seemed to be no fuel left. From here the Gospel was taken to the west toward the Mississippi and to the South.

*Ask of Me, and I will make the nations Your inheritance  
and the ends of the earth Your possession.*

Psalm 2:8

Robbie pointed out that the nations are here. God told His Son to ask Him for the nations, and encouraged the convention to do the same. "Can God use the BCNY to reach the nations?"

**The BCNY Vision Task Force Motion:**

... that the President establish a seven member Vision Task Force to develop a vision and strategy reflecting our churches' grassroots vision in order to strengthen the BCNY and maximize its support of churches and associations to evangelize lost people, strengthen churches, plant churches, and accomplish the Great Commission. Their recommendations will be brought to the 2012 annual meeting at Word of Life.

I further move this committee be established by the President appointing a Chair and then naming six additional members in consultation with the newly named Task Force Chair, the Executive Board Chairman and our Executive Director.

**Six additional aspects of this recommendation include:**

1. The messengers of the Convention call a 40-day season of prayer from Wednesday, September 28 through Sunday, November 6 while encouraging each Executive Board member to lead the churches in his or her association and fellowship to join in prayer.
2. The first initiative of this group would be to work with the Executive Board in facilitating listening sessions in each association and ethnic fellowship groups.
3. The Executive Director and Convention President would serve as *ex officio* members in addition to the 7 member Task Force.
4. The Task Force would report a rough draft of a vision, strategy and implementation changes to the Executive Board meeting on April 23, and make appropriate changes based on the feedback received from the Executive Board.
5. Upon making changes based on the Executive Board's feedback, the Task Force will share its current rough draft with each association and make final changes to the report.
6. Upon the approval of the final report at the 2012 annual meeting, the Task Force would become an advisory group to our Executive Director and BCNY's elected leadership for as long as it takes to implement the changes.

**Step 1. 40 Days of Fasting and Prayer**

40 days of prayer and fasting for God to reveal his preferred future to the churches immediately following the close of the 2011 annual meeting.

**Step 2. Recommendations of Vision Team**

**Members**

Leaders and Members of BCNY churches would be invited to recommend potential candidates to the President by the end of this season of prayer.

**Step 3. Listening Sessions throughout BCNY**

The first responsibility of the Vision Team would be to participate in listening sessions in every association, every fellowship group, and every region recognized within each association in order to hear what God has revealed to His churches. These listening sessions should be lead by the BCNY Executive Board members elected from each region.

**Step 4. Vision and Plan Shared with Executive Board**

The Team will formulate a rough draft of a vision and plan based on the church's input and will share the plan with BCNY's Executive Board for further input.

**Step 5. Plan Shared with Churches**

The Team will make the revised plan available to the Churches while receiving feedback

**Step 6. Recommendation to the 2012 Annual Meeting**

The Team will make the changes they deem appropriate and will recommend the final plan for approval at the 2012 annual meeting in Schroon Lake.

**Step 7. Vision Team Becomes an Advisory Group**

The Team will then become an ad hoc advisory group to the Executive Director and the Executive Board in order to support the implementation of the vision and plan as needed up to the 2014 annual meeting in Amherst.

It is also recommended that the BCNY's Executive Director, President and Executive Board Chairmen be *ex officio* members in addition to the 9 named by the President.

It is further recommended that the President name the Chair of this Team while allowing the Team to organize itself beyond this initial position.
