From the Convention Executive/Director

For I know the plans that I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Jeremiah 29:11

Spring is the time for change! The winter cold slowly changes into warmer temperatures, the precipitation changes from snow to rain, the sun attempts to burst through the clouds, and tree buds, green grass, and flowers reappear. Just as the season has changed, changes also will come to the Baptist Convention of New York territory, due to the reorganization of the North American Mission Board. For Southern Baptists, Great Commission Resurgence has been an effort demanding that all of us recognize the fact that we are commissioned to a focused plan. To fulfill the Great Commission of our Lord, NAMB has concluded that significant changes must be made. BCNY is on the verge of implementation of those changes. It is my intent to use this time to as clearly as possible share with you the changes that are soon to occur.

- 1. State and Multi-state Conventions will be addressed individually rather than using the same pattern for each.** Since BCNY is really the pilot project to implement changes, it is likely that others will benefit from lessons learned through our implementation.
- 2. Some current jointly-funded BCNY/NAMB positions will become 100% NAMB positions effective July 1, 2011.** The individuals in those positions will be directly paid by and receive employee benefits from NAMB.
- 3. The NAMB title for ADOM positions will be changed to Church Planting Catalyst effective July 1, 2011.** These individuals will not only be given a new title, but a new position description will also be developed. Monthly payment of these persons will be made directly by NAMB. If the association currently provides funds for the position in addition to the BCNY/NAMB jointly-funded amount that will be directly paid by the association to the Church Planting Catalyst.
- 4. NAMB Funding will cease for some other current jointly funded BCNY/NAMB positions effective not later than December 31, 2011.**
- 5. The use of the 94/6 matching fund formula will cease.** Beginning January 1, 2012, the approved funding from NAMB to BCNY will be sent monthly utilizing a 1/12th approach.

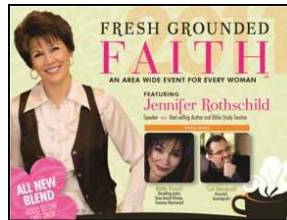
author and popular speaker at women's conferences and retreats, where she teaches the Word of God with great joy and enthusiasm. She also hosts highly

Dan was a man searching for a new life for himself and his family. His brother owned a piece of land in upstate New York and offered to let him build on it. So Dan, his wife Pat, and son Adam moved here all the way from Oklahoma with little more than each other. With a prison record that haunted him, work was hard for Dan to find, but eventually he did find employment.

They survived the first year living in a tent. Their dreams of a homestead and a simpler life kept them working relentlessly towards that end. They purchased an old trailer and began to refurbish it little by little. They dug their septic system by hand. In the winter they got their water by melting snow. Dan and his family were able to acquire some live-stock; chickens, and pigs. Bill, their neighbor lived a few miles up the road. He saw them working so hard and knew that they were trying to build a homestead. Bill and his wife Erma are lifelong dairy farmers and faithful followers of Jesus Christ. They determined to be good neighbors to Dan and his family. Bill would take his tractor over and help them. He was also able to teach Dan some of the ins and outs of managing livestock. Erma would invite them over to supper. Together they worked hard to show Dan, Pat, and Adam the love of Christ.

Every church gathering, Bill would ask the church to pray for his neighbor Dan. He would pray for Dan to come to know the Lord, but he would also pray for the Lord to help Dan in his struggle to build a new life. At every opportunity, Bill would make mention of the Lord to Dan. He often invited them to church. Meanwhile, he just kept praying for Dan and showing him the love of Christ.

One Sunday Dan and his family showed up to church. After visiting a few Sundays, Dan wanted to know more about the Lord. We met at his house and I shared the plan of salvation with him. As we talked, Dan literally quaked under the conviction of the Holy Spirit. Dan expressed his great desire to be saved, but he just could not yet believe that God would forgive him. Dan had shared with me about his prison record and how much rejection he had experienced because of it. Even churches had turned Dan away because of a crime for which he had already paid his debt to society. I recommended that Dan's first step should be to open up to Bill about it. Dan felt that he could not. Bill's friendship meant too much to him. Dan had a lot on him at that time. He was being forced to move. All that he had worked for was being pulled out from under him. Losing Bill's friendship was not a risk Dan wanted to take.

People were praying for Dan. He gave into the

Lord's prompting and opened up about his past to Bill. When Bill and Erma showed Dan unwavering love and grace, he knew that God was able to forgive him. Dan was ready! He said a sinner's prayer to verbalize the saving work that God was already doing in his heart, but the tears of joy that rolled down Dan's cheeks at that moment really said it all. Dan was hungry for God. He read his Bible daily and was growing stronger in the faith. That is when Dan was hit with a bad series of strokes, knocking out most of his mobility and ability to talk. He had been working around the clock tearing down his little homestead and searching for a place for his family to move. I was concerned that Dan might despair after being rendered invalid. So we were praying and had others praying for him also. When I saw him 3 days after the stroke, he was walking, talking, and praising God. He still did not have use of his hand and the doctors told him there was a good chance he wouldn't get it back. While I was visiting him, I offered to read his Bible to him because I knew his head was still hurting too bad to read. I opened to where he had left off in Mark's gospel. It was the story of the man with the withered hand. When I finished the story, Dan was ecstatic, he said, "Jesus healed the man's hand." Dan saw God at work in the fact that that was the first story we came to. You could see the spark of faith in his eyes! The next morning his wife went to see him after working an all night shift at Wal-Mart. Dan walked up to her and squeezed her arm with the hand that had the paralysis. He told her to go straight to church and tell everyone that God is doing miracles!

Dan was released from the hospital that Tuesday. When he came home he was still weak. He had to use a cane and he had a hard time getting his thoughts together but there was no denying the miracle that God had done for him. Dan was still faced with all the challenges he had before the strokes. After being home about a week, it all started to overwhelm him. He cried out to God, "Lord, I trust you, but I don't know how much more I can take." At that very moment Dan received his physical strength back into his body! Dan was so excited he woke his wife up to show her. He immediately drove to Bill and Erma's to show them. When he went to his doctor's appointment two days after receiving his strength back the doctor released him to go back to work, 30 hours a week. Dan's wife, Erma was saved on Easter Sunday morning!

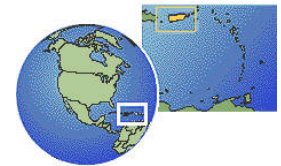

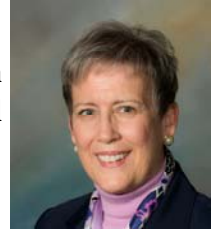

COURAGEOUS

HONOR BEGINS AT HOME

"BUT AS FOR ME AND MY HOUSEHOLD, WE WILL SERVE THE LORD." JOSHUA 24:15

During the first week of April, Tommy Echols, BCNY Church Growth Division Director, and LifeWay's Gary Jennings, traveled with the movie, *Courageous* to facilitate its BCNY territory's preview showings.

Here is the story line of the movie: Four men, one calling: To serve and protect. As law enforcement officers, Adam Mitchell, Nathan Hayes, and their partners are confident and focused. They willingly stand up to the worst the world can offer. Yet at the end of the day, they face a challenge that none of them are truly prepared to tackle: fatherhood. While they consistently give their best on the job, good enough seems to be all they can muster as dads. But they're quickly discovering that their standard is missing the mark. They know that God desires to turn the hearts of fathers to their children, but their children are beginning to drift further and further



away from them. Will they be able to find a way to serve and protect those that are most dear to them? When tragedy hits home, these men are left wrestling with their hopes, their fears,



their faith, and their fathering. Can a newfound urgency help these dads draw closer to God ... and to their children?

Moviegoers will again find themselves crying, laughing, and cheering—sometimes simultaneously—as they are inspired by everyday heroes who long to be the kinds of dads that make a lifelong impact on their children. Protecting the streets is second nature to these law enforcement officers. Raising their children? That will take courage. **Courageous ... honor begins at home.**

The movie is scheduled to premier on September 30.

What you may not know, is that the BCNY has a connection to this movie. Tyler Morris, age 22, son of Cliff and Valerie Morris, who served in the Ithaca area for 15 years, worked on **Courageous**. The Morris family, Cliff, Valerie, Marshall, Weston, Tyler, and Mallory, left New York when Tyler was 17. He obtained his Bachelor's Degree in Film from at Full Sail University in Orlando.

The following is an interview with

Tyler.

What was your job for the movie, *Courageous*? My crew position on *Courageous* was a "Grip." Most people have no clue what a grip actually does. A Grip is a part of the lighting department for a movie crew. A huge reason why movies take so long to shoot is because we have to set up lighting for every scene and every single shot. The Grip department helps control the light being cast onto the set and most importantly the actors. In other words, we help make the shot look beautiful for the camera's



eye to see. It's a very physically grueling position, as we are often working 12 to 16 hours a day through the rain, desert heat, or any other element you can think of all while lifting and rigging heavy gear and barely getting a chance to sit down. We do it because we love making movies, and it's a very rare chance to get to work on a film that will actually change people's lives.

How did you get the Job working on the movie? While I was in film school I met a great life-long friend who also happened to be a P.K. His Dad, Pastor Ed Litton of First Baptist

of Mobile, Alabama, is great friends with Pastor Michael Catt and Jim McBride of Sherwood Baptist in Albany, Georgia. So through my film school friend, I landed this position on "Courageous" after driving to Albany Georgia, to have lunch with Director and Producer, Alex and Stephen Kendrick. During this meeting, they told me that they only wanted true Christians working on their films, so that it could glorify God not just after its release date, but during the production process as well. It was my first movie right out of school and I was a little nervous because I was working with people that have been in the movie business for decades.

What was the most memorable thing that happened in the filming of the movie? There were so many memorable things that happened during the film, I don't think I could just give you one. A very memorable thing that you will never see on any other film set is the morning devotions. Most mornings the crew of nearly 60 or 70 would have to report to set by seven AM. There would be a pastor from the area giving a devotion and a prayer for the day. There are so many things that can go wrong on a movie set and every morning we would pray for God's blessing to help us film what we needed to get for the day in a safe way and we always managed to get the footage that we needed. Some other fun and memorable moments were the shoot out scenes. These scenes were so much fun to film and it was great to see the actors get into the moment shooting live blank rounds. It was very loud and being a guy, it was just so much fun to be a part of the action-packed sequence. Just one more memorable moment! One day we were shooting in a very bad area of town. There were about 15 neighborhood children playing in a park across

the street from where we were shooting. While we were setting up for another scene, one of the actors who played a gangster, was across the street talking to these kids. He ended up leading somewhere between 5 to 7 of children to the Lord at once. It was funny to see him play a hardcore gangster in the movie, then disappear from set to lead half a dozen neighborhood kids to God all in the same day.

How did you know you wanted to be involved in film-making? I can remember back to when I was in first or second grade, making stop-motion movies with the family video camera. This was when I first became involved in filmmaking. My oldest brother taught me how to do it and ever since then, I was always shooting some kind of short film or video. I just simply loved filming. I didn't know that I could make a living doing it until I was older and that's when I decided to go to school for it.

What is your present Job? Right now I am working at a design firm in Dayton, Ohio. I am their in-house filmmaker and I shoot anything from commercials to promotional videos. It's a Full time position whereas feature film work is considered freelance contract work. I would love to work on another Sherwood film if they decide to do another one. I can't wait to see **Courageous**. Many people have already seen it. I only saw it on set and had to piece it together in my head because every scene is shot out of order. I will absolutely be making a trip to the theaters this September to watch it.

Have you worked on any other films? I have worked on two other feature films since **Courageous**. One called "October Baby" and another called "After". Many of the people I worked with on **Courageous** worked on these films as well. That's how I

got connected with these films. "After" was directed by Michael W. Smith's son, Ryan Smith. Michael W. Smith was often on set. It was a fun project to work on. "October baby" was a wonderful project as well and I got to work with John Schneider from the old "Dukes of Hazard." He was a great guy.

What are some of your memories you have from living in New York? One of the best memories I have about upstate New York is how beautiful it is. People that have never been to New York don't realize how green it is and how it has so many beautiful landscapes. In Ithaca we had many waterfalls and gorges. New York is the most beautiful place I have ever lived. It was a great place to grow up.
